



## **BP 2432 SUPERINTENDENT/PRESIDENT SUCCESSION**

### **References:**

Education Code Sections 70902(d) and 72400;  
Title 5 Section 53021(b)

The Board delegates authority to the Superintendent/President to appoint an acting Superintendent/President to serve in his/her absence for short periods of time, not to exceed 30 calendar days at a time.

In the event the Superintendent/President is absent, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to perform his/her duties, and when an acting president has not been named, administrative responsibility shall reside with (in order):

1. Executive Vice President Educational Programs
2. Vice President Business Services
3. Vice President Information Technology
4. Vice President Human Resources

The Board shall appoint an acting Superintendent/President for periods exceeding 30 calendar days.
